# 2023 LARIMER COUNTY FAIR & PRCA RODEO THROUGH THE DECADES

### - 140TH LARIMER COUNTY FAIR & 75TH PRCA RODEO -

The Fair and Rodeo is that time of year when the whole community comes together to celebrate the cooler months ahead, the dedication of 4-H members in their projects, the sport of Rodeo, to splurge on a corndog and grab a ride on the Ferris wheel.

We are proud the Larimer County Fair has something for everyone from the Community Stage, Sensory Day, great food and attractions, local vendors and artists, and most notably, 4-H members and CSU extension. Our 4-H and CSU extension members, leaders, superintendents, and their families bring the heart and soul to the Fair. Their generosity combines yearlong efforts of hard work from planning and working on their projects to getting them across the finish line for the Fair. Their efforts and selflessness humble us.

Since hosting the Fair and Rodeo at The Ranch Events Complex, 2023 brought record attendance with over 120,000 people and a successful carnival.

2023 was also a special year for the Larimer County Fair and PRCA Rodeo celebrating two significant accomplishments: the 140th County Fair and the 75th PRCA Rodeo.

The Ranch Events Complex, a property proudly owned by Larimer County, has hosted the County Fair and Rodeo for 20 years, and we were excited to celebrate such major and historical occasions.

These celebrations were launched with the historic Larimer County Fair community parade in downtown Loveland the weekend before the Fair opened to the public, and we saw many local organizations, businesses, 4-H families, and the familiar faces of the Larimer County Commissioners supporting the work of staff and volunteers.

The Loveland Foundry played host to a live-band after-parade event that was a catalyst for all the following anniversary celebrations.

The Watering Hole Bar and Entertainment Center hosted the 140th Fair Anniversary party hosted by the Larimer County Commissioners for the community at large. The event was opened by former Larimer County Commissioner and visionary for The Ranch, Kathay Rennels, with addresses and thanks following from Larimer County Commissioners Kristin Stephens, Jody Shadduck-McNally, and John Kefalas. Larimer County Extensions Office had a noticeable 4H presence alongside former Queens at the event, which was a nice reflection point of the path the Fair and Rodeo has taken people before us down.

Overarchingly, the anniversaries were a triumphant celebration of bringing together our local and 4H community, and through the dedication of Ranch staff, Commissioners, and Fair and Rodeo Boards, they were a huge success.

Many notable events occur within the Fair, including the annual Queens BBQ, which was again a huge success. The Pancake Breakfast was another popular event with more than 750 attendees, and the Rodeo hosted some of the highest attendance in recent years.

We thank and are indebted to our partners and sponsors, who support the Larimer County Fair and Rodeo each year. We truly appreciate their support after some tough years many have experienced due to the COVID-19 pandemic. With the traffic counter, we estimated about 131,950 unique visitors.


#### 2. CELL PHONE CAPTURE

### PRCA RODEO



**SUNDAY - 3,146** 




