


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# THE MISSION OF BLUE ARENA

OVG is a proud partner of The Ranch and Larimer County, serving our Northern Colorado community with quality entertainment since 2003. We are extremely thrilled to share that 2024 was our strongest financial performance year on record for Blue Arena, with an operating net profit of over \$1.1 million. That's attributed to the hard work and entrepreneurial spirit of our entire OVG team at The Ranch.

We hosted 153 events this past year, which brought in \$2,511,491 in revenue. In addition to our events' financial success, patrons who visited Blue Arena provided high marks through our Customer Satisfaction Surveys, averaging 4.5 out of 5. 2024 provided many amazing event experiences and standout performances. Nate Bargatze had the highest attended event since 2014 with over 6,400 patrons, and Weezer, Bert Kreischer, Lauren Daigle and Mercy Me performed before near sellout capacity crowds. The summer saw the return of professional wrestling with AEW Dynamite, and the first performance of Big Head Todd and The Monsters at Blue Arena. We continued rocking in the fall with Steve Miller Band, Godsmack, and Judas Priest. Family content remains a programming staple with events like Cirque Corteo, Harlem Globetrotters, Disney on Ice, Toughest Monster Truck Tour, Sesame Street Live, our Larimer County PRCA Rodeo and New Year's Eve Extreme Bulls providing quality entertainment last year.

OVG Global Partnerships (OVG GP) continues to drive record revenues in sponsorships and advertising for Blue Arena, with over \$3.3 million in total sales for 2024.

As we look forward to 2025, our focus remains steadfast on providing a diversity of first-class events and customer service for our Northern Colorado community, while being fiscally responsible on behalf of Larimer County. We continue to diligently strive to provide exceptional experiences Oak View Group is known for in this next year.

With this report, we would like to express our gratitude to Larimer County for its continued support and we are excited to see what 2025 will bring to the amazing Ranch Event Complex.



Blue Arena at The Ranch, located in Loveland, Colorado, is a 6,800 seat multi-purpose venue that opened in September 2003. It is home to the Colorado Eagles of the American Hockey League.

The arena, which is owned by Larimer County, is managed by Oak View Group (OVG). Oak View Group is an industry leader in hosting entertainment and partnering with clients to create memorable experiences for millions of visitors every year. OVG's unmatched blend of integrated services delivers incremental value for clients through several primary areas of expertise: Venue Management, Food Services & Hospitality and Corporate Partnerships.

This multipurpose facility can host concert settings in various capacities, hockey, basketball, football, family shows, rodeos, trade shows and flexible set-ups to accommodate any event. Blue Arena, located less than an hour drive from Denver, Colorado and Cheyenne, Wyoming has become the focal point for sports and entertainment in Northern Colorado. Blue Arena is part of a larger 374,000 square-foot fairgrounds known as the Ranch Events Complex, which is the official name of the Larimer County Fairgrounds and Events Complex.




