

## How Does the Sale Work?

The animals are sold by the head not the weight. Prior to the sale, the current market price of each species of animals is determined by the area processing facilities. All prospective buyers will receive a packet of information containing the youth's name, species being sold, weight of the animal and their market price. Species are sold on a rotating basis.

If you are the highest bidder, you will be asked to sign a sales slip indicating if the animal is for resale (Option A), donation (Option B), or for personal consumption (Option C).

Buyers will receive a complimentary photograph of the animal taken with their exhibitor.

### Bidding Process: Buyer's Options

**Option A: Resale** – The buyer bids on an animal and upon the successful bid, the buyers pay the difference between the bid price and the established market price. The animal is then sold to a processor at the market price.

**Option B: Food Bank Donation** – Animals sold may be purchased and donated to the Food Bank of Larimer County (except rabbits & poultry).

**Option C: Personal Use** – Animals may be purchased for the buyer's personal consumption. A list of pre-determined processors will be available. Delivery to the processor will be arranged by the Livestock Sale Committee.

**Additional Contributions or Add-Ons** are easy and a great way to increase the total sale price for youth. The add-on amount is directly credited to the total sale amount for the youth you chose and no bidding necessary to participate. Additional contributions can also be made to a particular species or the overall livestock sale.

The minimum amount to add on is \$20 and can be submitted starting August 5<sup>th</sup> by going to the QR code below.
