Quality

The goal of all Livestock 4-H members is to bring the best animals in Larimer County to the Junior Livestock Sale. It is the responsibility of the youth exhibitors to follow all Wholesome Meat Assurance Program guidelines when feeding and caring for their project in order to provide a safe and wholesome product.

Your participation in this sale is a tribute to the 4-H youth—recognizing and rewarding the **COMMITMENT, DEDICATION** and **HARD WORK** of raising **QUALITY** animals.

A Complimentary Barbecue Dinner will be provided for buyers from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

How Does the Sale Work?

The sale starts at 4:30 PM, Wednesday, August 11th at The Ranch—Larimer County Fairgrounds in the Mac Equipment, Inc. Arena. The animals are sold by the head not by weight. Prior to the sale, the current market price of each species of animals is determined by the area processing facilities. All perspective buyers will receive a packet of information containing the youth's name, species being sold, weight of the animal and their market price. Species are sold on a rotating basis.

If you are the highest bidder, you will be asked to sign a sales slip indicating if the animal is for resale (Option A), donation (Option B) or for personal consumption (Option C).

Buyers will receive a complimentary photograph of the animal taken with their exhibitor.

Bidding Process : Buyer's Options

Option A: Resale— The buyer bids on an animal and upon the successful bid, the buyer pays the difference between the bid price and the established market price. The animal is then sold to a processor at the market price.

Example: Bid is \$1000 for a 240 lb. Swine

BID	=	\$1000
MARKET PRICE	=	\$450
BUYER PAYS	=	\$550

Option B: Food Bank Donation— Animals may be purchased and donated to the Food Bank for Larimer County.

Option C: Personal Use—Animals may be purchased for the buyer's own personal consumption. A list of predetermined processors will be available. Delivery to the processor will be arranged by the Livestock Sale

Additional Contributions or Add-Ons are easy and a great way to increase the total sale price for a youth. The add-on amount is directly credited to the total sale amount for the youth you choose and no bidding is necessary to participate. Additional contributions can also be made to a particular species or the overall livestock sale. Any amount is accepted.
