# **Evolving The Ranch After 20 Years**

The Ranch Events Complex has officially been open to the public for 20 years! The Ranch opened in September 2003, making it the first year the complex hosted the Larimer County Fair and PRCA Rodeo. The complex is possible thanks to the help of long-time fair advocates and many 4-H families and friends who helped pass a measure by Larimer County voters in 1998 to allow for a one-year sales tax to purchase the land that now houses the fair. In 1999, another measure was passed to support the construction of The Ranch, including a state-of-the-art complex with 242 acres of land and over 375,000 square feet of indoor event space.

In addition to the beloved Larimer County Fair, The Ranch Events Complex has become

known as a premier event and entertainment complex and has hosted a variety of events including trade shows, conferences, concerts, festivals, hockey games and more! The Ranch serves as a community gathering place, a major economic driver and a cultural and entertainment experience. It facilitates educational and agricultural opportunities and serves as a hub for community activities and events. The complex has and will continue to play a vital role in enhancing the lives of the Larimer County community.

The Ranch developed a Master Plan in 2017 to begin laying a framework for how the complex can maintain and expand its role in the community and county over the next 20 years. Through extensive stakeholder discussions and expert analysis, the Master Plan is now moving forward with six key goals in mind:

- 1. Provide entertainment, meeting, and agricultural facilities and events that satisfy community and market demands in Northern Colorado and Southern Wyoming.
- 2. Provide affordable, quality event space for business and community groups.
- Safeguard County assets and effectively manage operational costs by utilizing resources efficiently, leveraging strategic partnerships, and continuously improving and innovating practices.
- 4. Strive to generate sufficient revenue to operate self-sufficiently and support County residents' recreational and community needs and activities.
- 5. Provide high-quality experiences for all users.
- 6. Produce a successful Larimer County Fair and PRCA Rodeo.

These goals, along with a culmination of research, influenced the types of projects The Ranch team chose to move forward with, which include a new 4-H, Youth, and Community Livestock Arena, roadway improvements, improvements to the MAC, Equipment Inc. Indoor Arena and Maintenance and Department of Natural Resources building, new RV hookups and a new outdoor riding arena. Phase 1 of construction is nearing completion, and visitors to the complex can see the initial improvements come to life!



## **The Ranch Heart Unveiling**

To celebrate the 20th anniversary of The Ranch Events Complex, The Ranch hosted an anniversary party on Sunday, Oct. 15 and unveiled a brand new heart sculpture. The heart sculpture is part of the City with HeART Program led by the Loveland Chamber of Commerce. The fiberglass heart is 5 feet tall and 4.5 feet wide and joins a network of heart sculptures in Loveland designed to encourage people of all ages to have fun and celebrate the HeARTs of our community.

#### **Construction Updates and Zones**

Construction is nearing completion on the 4-H, Youth, and Community Livestock Arena and the MAC Equipment, Inc. Indoor Arena. Crews are currently working on the interior of the buildings.

The new Arena Circle opened in May and all three supporting roads, Richard Rule Road, Show Ring Road and Clydesdale Parkway, are now open. Work also continues on the future RV camping locations on the northeast end of the complex. Crews recently completed paving and striping the RV parking lot.


